



1. List three different plants that can you see growing in the Agra Living garden?
2. What are the different parts of plants that we can eat? Eg. Which part of a plant is a carrot? Is it a root, a stem or leaf
3. What other living things might be found in gardens or in nature around Bermuda?
4. Compare the leaves of the different plants using as many adjectives as possible (their size, texture, quantity, colour, etc... )
5. Find the compost pile in the Farm Garden. Can you guess why this method of composting is sometimes compared to "lasagne" ? What are the three different ingredients?

## Things to do and talk about during your excursion:

### SING A SONG!

Help your child create their own jingle/ song about plant growth to the melody of a popular nursery song.

For example: Using the 'Head and Shoulders' melody :

*" Soil, sun and water too, water too,  
Soil, sun and water too, water too  
Watch the seed grow some roots, a stem and some leaves too  
Soil, sun and water too, water too!"*
