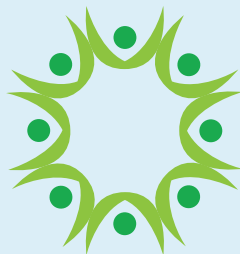

WE'RE GOING ON A BEAR HUNT

Before reading, ask:

- Have you ever been on a Bear Hunt?
- Would you like to go on one?
- What would you take with you?

While looking at the front cover, ask:

- What can you see?
- How many people are on the front cover?
- Where do you think they are?

As you are reading:

- Encourage your child to sing “We’re going on a bear hunt, we’re going to catch a big one, what a beautiful day” while you point to the phrase.
- Have children act out all the parts of the story that require movement (e.g- going through water “splash splash”, going through mud “squelch squelch”.)

Discussion Questions

- + What do you think bears eat?
- + What might the family be thinking and feeling when they see the bear?
- + How do you think the bear feels at the end of the story?
- + Do you think the bear will return?

Be sure to congratulate your child on a job well done, and continue to encourage them to read more!
