

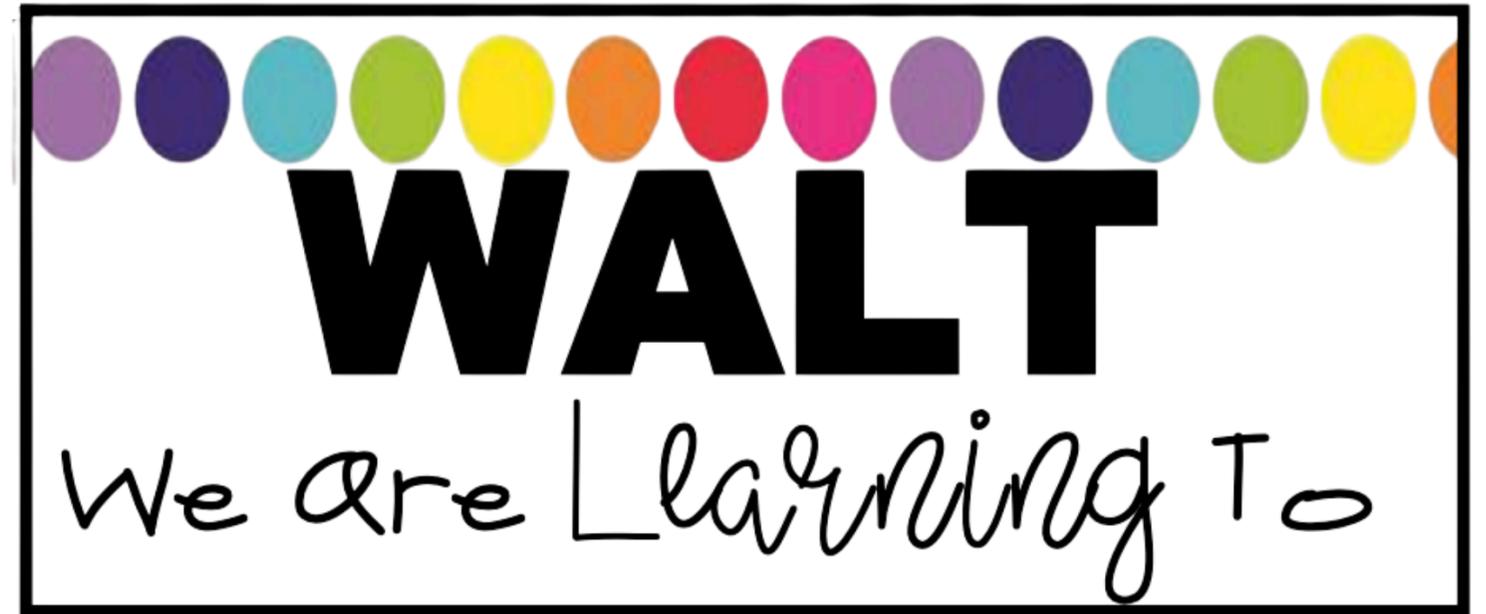
WALT & Success Criteria


