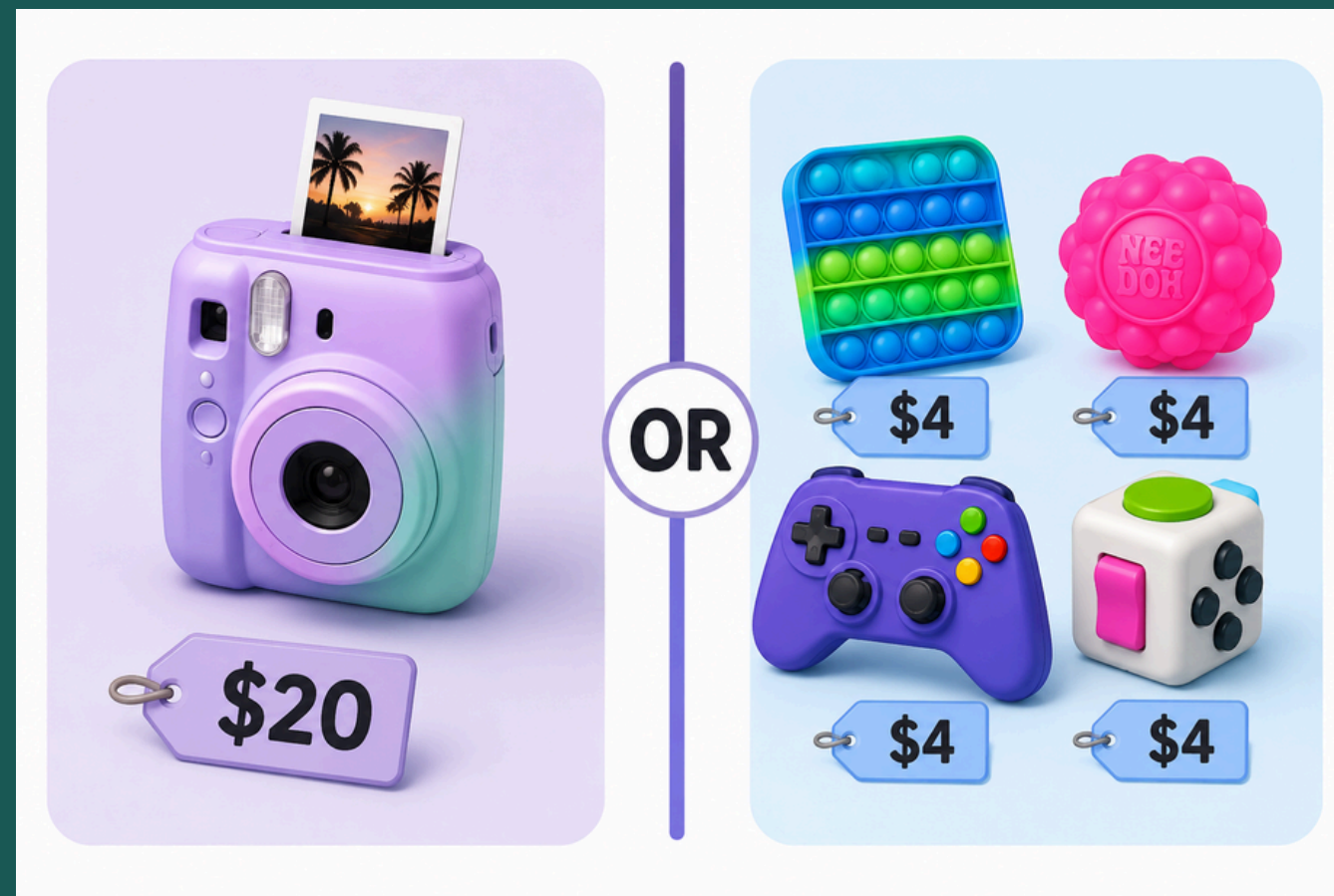
WOULD YOU RATHER?

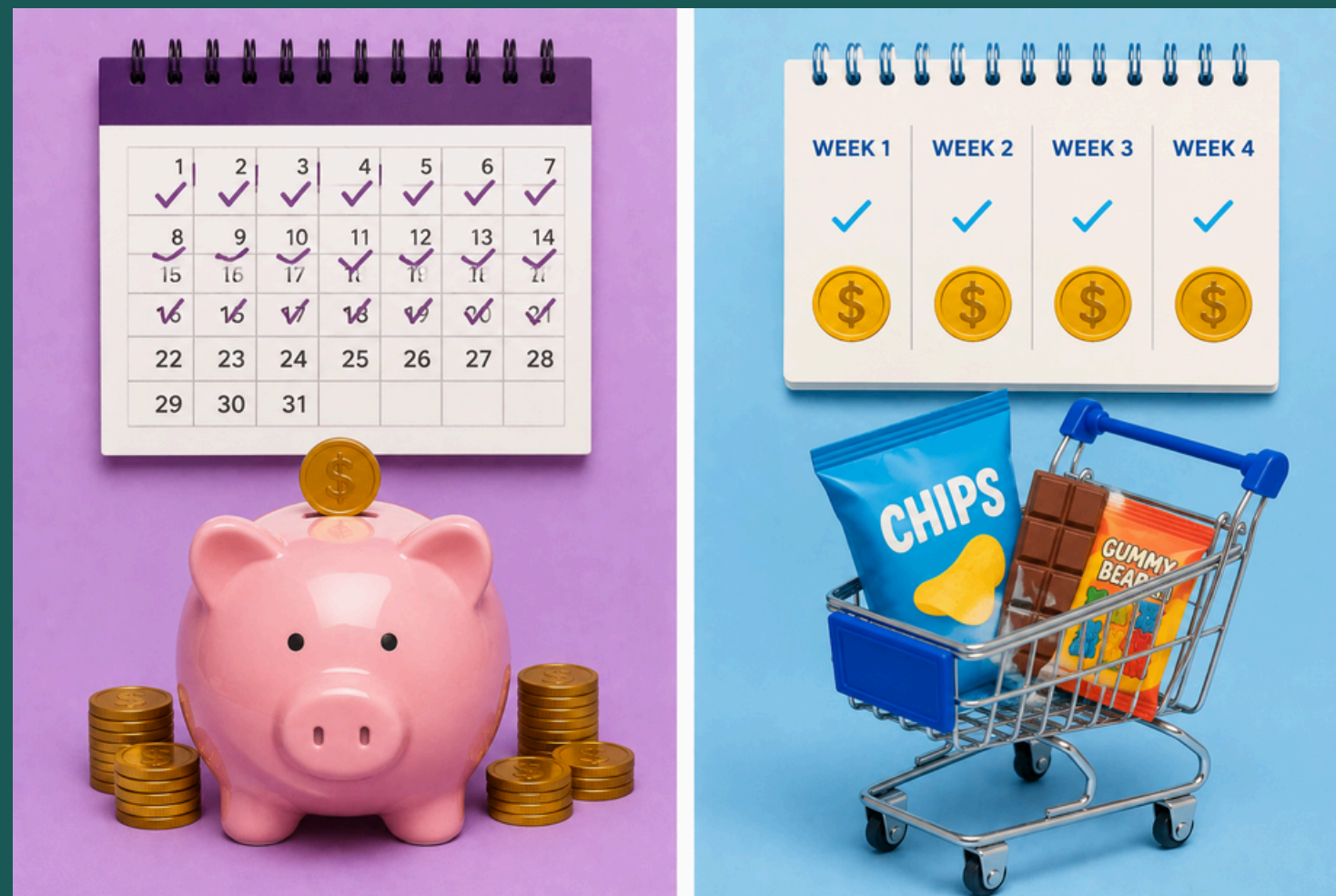
